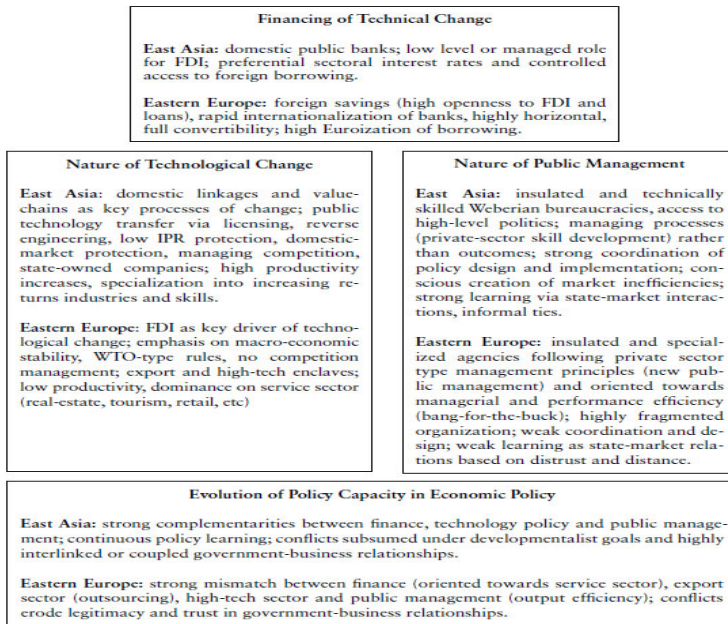


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Figure 1: Policy capacity for development in East Asia and Eastern Europe
